This notice is to inform you that the State of Colorado's Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety is currently involved in an enforcement action against a possible unpermitted operation in San Juan County. Through our records review in conjunction with the San Juan County Assessor's Office it has been determined that all or part of the surface disturbance associated with this site lies on the Hobo Patented Claim, Claim No. 4276. Records indicate you are the surface owner for this claim, and during the inspection conducted on September 18, 2017 the Operator, who owns the mineral rights to this claim, indicated that no contact had been made with the surface owners.

No action is required of you at this time, the enforcement action is being conducted against the owner of the mineral rights of this claim.
