Dear Mr. Newman,

On October 12, 2017, the Division notified Colorado Land Legacy (CLL) of the additional materials required to file the Application for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators for the Schwartzwalder Mine. On October 13, 2017 the Division received the additional materials which included the Applicant's waiver of their right to a decision within 30 days and a demonstration of legal right of entry to the Schwartzwalder Mine. The signed and notarized letter from the current landowner states CLL will have a legal right to enter the property upon transfer of the Reclamation Permit. In order for the Prospective Successor to assume all responsibility for the Schwartzwalder Mine, the Prospective Successor must demonstrate it has obtained a legal right of entry from any and all surface and mineral rights owners of the affected lands. A legal right of entry which becomes effective in the future or which is contingent upon the transfer of the Reclamation Permit will not be accepted.

Please return the required documentation to the Division on or before December 11, 2017. If the requested documentation is not submitted, the application may be terminated.
