Dear Mr. Miller.

The above-mentioned site has had one or more problems noted that, according to Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) records have not yet been resolved. According to our records, the following problems were to be resolved on or before October 11, 2017. Listed below are descriptions and corrective actions for the problems. Please resolve the corrective actions and provide evidence of such resolution on or before November 30, 2017.

Please note that if the corrective action(s) are not properly addressed, and evidence provided to the Division by the date provided above, the listed problems could be escalated to the level of possible violations and would then be referred to the Mined Land Reclamation Board for further action.

1. **Problem:** There are state-listed noxious weeds present on site. **Corrective Action:** The operator shall develop a weed control and management plan in accordance with Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rule. This plan should be developed in consultation with the county extension agency, or weed control district office and should include: a list of noxious weeds present at the site, the specific control measures to be applied, a schedule for when control measures will be applied and a post-treatment monitoring plan. This weed control plan shall be submitted to the Division as a Modification to the approved NOI with the appropriate Modification fee of \$86.00 by the corrective action date. In additition, the Operator will be required to demonstrate the approved weed control methods have been implemented at the site during the fall season of 2017.
