The BLM received a Succession of Operators application on October 6th 2017 for mining activities located in Township 9 South, Range 77 West, Section 33 in Park County, CO. The BLM has reviewed the application and has found it complete. Before the change of operator can be accepted by the BLM, the new operator must satisfy the financial guarantee requirements under 43 CFR 3809.551.

According to our records, the Plan of Operations submitted for mining activities at this location was analyzed through our National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process under document number DOI-BLM-CO-2009-0099-EA in July 2009. BLM authorized these operations on July 11, 2012.

Please note the new operator must provide the BLM with an acceptable financial guarantee covering proposed operations before the new operator may begin operations. We understand this filing with the BLM is coordinated with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (CDRMS). Therefore, please coordinate with CDRMS to obtain the appropriate paperwork that will include BLM as a co-obligee on the financial guarantee for this operation.
