Dear Mr. Hays,

St. Vrain Sanitation District ("District") is aware of Barefoot LLC's existing slurry wall that was constructed and recently repaired around the ponds (former gravel pits) north of St. Vrain Creek and east of Interstate 25. We understand that a Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety permit renewal is required for the slurry wall's recent repair.

The damage to the District's infrastructure previously caused by the construction of the subdivision and lakes is being repaired which should not have any negative effect on sewer service to the area. Any future construction within two hundred (200) feet of the permit boundary should take measures as to not damage existing infrastructure. The Applicant, Barefoot LLC, is ultimately liable for operations pertaining to the reclamation of the ponds and agrees to compensate any damages to any utility's structure.
