This response consists of comments and permit revisions regarding and addressing questions identified in the Second RN-04 Adequacy Review dated November 24, 2017, consisting of two of the seven Adequacy Items from the first RN-04 Adequacy Review:

Adequacy Item 3

Pages 2.05-60 and 2.05-71a have been revised to be in agreement to two of the final ten years for grazing. It is noted that at this moment Hill Rach management is not orientated toward grazing.

Adequacy Item 4

Pages 2.05-73 and 2.05-73a have been revised to be in agreement to a 1 by 25 meter transect belt. This is the transect belt size used by Arcadis in the most recent vegetation survey done in 2015.
