As required by Colorado Division of Reclamation for regulatory review processes, this letter serves as verification that Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C ("CIG"), and Holcim (US) Inc., are working collaboratively to ensure that the activities of each company does not impact the continuing operations for the above noted organizations.
