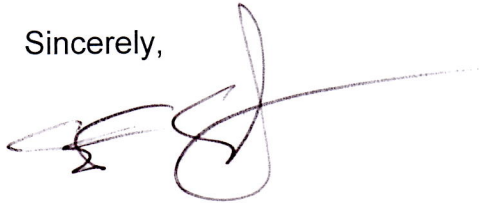
Ms. Eschberger,

As a property owner and current resident in the Southwest Highway 115 area adjacent to the planned quarry, I object to Transit Mix Concrete Company's (TM's) application M2017-049 to establish a quarry on Hitch Rack Ranch.
