Ms. Eschberger,

As a property owner and resident in the Southwest Highway 115 area, I object to Transit Mix Concrete Company's (TM's) application M2017-049 to establish a quarry on Hitch Rack Ranch.

We are outraged that this proposal is given any consideration to be passed at all. The "Scar" in Colorado Springs is enough of an eyesore to the entire community that every citizen would say "NO! NEVER AGAIN!! It shows how LITTLE Transit Mix cares about their operations!

We already have 3 existing quarries down Highway 115—none of which are working at full capacity!

The application jeopardizes the water resources of local residents, fails to protect critical wildlife habitat, and violates the easement rights of several property owners along Little Turkey Creek Road. I urge the Mine Land Reclamation Board (MLRB) to deny TM's application.

I request that both the Pre-hearing Conference and MLRB Hearing be conducted in Colorado Springs.
