Dear Ms. Eschberger,

I object to the application (permit M2017-049) for Transit Mix to conduct quarry operation in my parent's neighborhood. The area is called Red Rock Valley Estates, which is just north to the proposed quarry site. I lived in that neighborhood for19 years and I have a hard time believing a company as large as TM would stoop so low in upsetting a country side neighborhood with so many homes nearby.

Their application jeopardizes the water resources in the Red Rock Valley neighborhood! Property values will decrease. I don't know of anyone who would want that for their homes.

TM's intent causes so many concerns for the neighbors here. The application violates easement rights of property owners along Little Turkey Creek Road. The quarry would also interrupt the natural wildlife habitat, which would be hazardous to this vast beautiful mountain area, which is so close to the city.

There will be plenty of noise due to blasting. I wouldn't want the blasting, truck traffic noise, and the potential for flying loose rock when blasting does occur. TM's plans were downsized; however, it would be easy for them to gain approval later to expand.

I request the pre-hearing conference and MLRB bearing to be conducted in Colorado Springs.
