This is no longer the 19th century, and we do not need another quarry, certainly not one that would impact so many rural residents near a major metropolitan region.

The application not only fails to protect water resources, wildlife habitat and ecosystem services, but also the easement rights of several property owners along Little Turkey Creek Road. I urge the Mine Land Reclamation Board (MLRB) to **deny TM's application**.
