As a homeowner and resident of the Highway 115 community I strongly object to the quarry proposed on Application M2017-049, a new quarry known as the Hitch Rock Ranch Quarry. This application fails to protect the water resources, wildlife habitat and easement rights of multiple owners along Little Turkey Creek Road. Additionally, a new quarry would add hundreds of heavy duty trucks per day to an already busy highway. I travel Highway 115 daily and am amazed at the number of heavy trucks carrying quarry material that are out there now. There's nothing like sitting at the light at Ft Carson's hospital gate behind a rock-carrying truck with smoking brakes caused by bringing that massive load to a stop as it descends that steep hill. Surely an accident waiting to happen if hundreds of additional truck loads are added.
