As previously discussed, it has come to the attention of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) that the assigned annual fee for the Duck Creek Mine, Permit No. M-2013-022, is incorrect. Pursuant to C.R.S 34-32-127(2)(a)(IV)(B), the annual fee for a 110(2) operation is \$259.00, however, the Division has been incorrectly invoicing you an annual fee of \$518.00 for three years. The Division sincerely apologizes for this inconvenience and in order to correct the situation, is refunding you the excess which has been paid to date.
