Mr. Schenderlein:

On December 19, 2017, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the 110 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application incompleteness response for the Harmony Windsor Site, File No. M-2017-056. The review of the information received determined the following items must be received before the Division can consider the application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

Application Form

- 1. The Division requires the permit application list the exact company name registered with the Colorado Secretary of State, "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."
 - a. Please revise the company name on Page 1, Item #1 on the application form, to indicate "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."
 - b. Please revise the company name on the Applicant/Operator correspondence information section on Page 2 of the application form to indicate "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."
 - c. Please revise the company name on the name of owner of the subsurface rights of the affected land and the name of owner of the surface of affected land sections on Page 3 of the application form to indicate "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."
 - d. Please revise the company name on the Applicant/Operator or Company Name section and the notary section of the certification page, Page 8 of the application form, to indicate "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."



- 2. Please revise the "Authorization Letter for Blue Earth Solutions, LLC" to indicate the exact company name registered with the Colorado Secretary of State office, "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."
- 3. Please revise the "Property and Mining Site Access Agreement" to indicate the exact company name registered with the Colorado Secretary of State office, "Serfer Land Ventures, LLC."

4. Please provide an affidavit or receipt indicating the date on which the <u>revised</u> application pages in response to this letter were placed with the Weld County Clerk and Recorder.

The application will not be considered filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 30 days from the date of receipt of all of the requested information. Additionally, if you have already published notice you will need to republish notice, after the Division considers the application submitted. Republication must occur once within ten (10) days of the submittal date. We will notify you when you should initiate republication of your notice. The final date for receiving comments is ten (10) days after the date of publication or the next regular business day.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office shall deny the application and terminate the application file. **The response due date is February 27, 2018.**

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
