Dear Jared:

In the Division's report of its November 8, 2017 inspection at the Hazeltine Mine, Availability of Records was cited as a problem with regard to missing or incomplete data for HZMW-2 and SG-2 for monitoring year 2017 as submitted with the 2017 annual report. The available data for these two monitoring points was submitted with the annual report.

Data for SG-2 from January through July 2017 was not available because the gauge had to be temporarily removed following the December 12, 2016 monitoring event to accommodate construction of the Orr Drain. A new gauge was re-installed and monthly monitoring resumed in August 2017. Monthly monitoring is now on-going.

As noted on the data sheet for HZMW-2, that monitoring well was inaccessible. Data was collected in June 2016; however, following those monitoring events, it was determined that access to the monitoring well was not safe. Aggregate and its consultants are working towards determining a solution for providing safe access and monitoring of that well will resume when safe access can be achieved.
