A weed control plan is in place for the Jefferson County Pine Junction Pit. It consists of spring and fall property inspections to identify Noxious weed species which may be present followed by any necessary chemical applications. A considerable population of Chamomile and mullein was present around the rock piles as well as a large patch of myrtle spurge south of the loop road. Other light populations of weeds such as Prickly Poppy, Diffuse Knapweed, Bindweed, Cocklebur, Yellow Sweetclover, and a mix of Thistles were also located and treated throughout the property. The chemicals Hi-Dep at 32oz per acre, Escort at 1oz per acre and Vista at 22oz per acre were selected to treat the property. The application was made on September 19th and 20th 2017 from 8:00am-2:30pm
