Dear Mr. Golden:

On January 16, 2018, the Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division), received a letter from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) regarding your proposed Plan of Operations modification. The Division reached out to Jennifer Maiolo with the BLM to inquire further about the proposed changes, submitted in your December 13, 2017 request. Based on the information received from her, the Division believes these changes will also require a technical revision to your permit. The fabric structure may not be installed until approved by both agencies.

Please complete the attached the technical revision request form and submit it with the required \$216 fee. Please submit whatever additional information you feel necessary to accurately depict the desired changes and aid in the Divisions decision. You may make multiple minor changes under one technical revision request and fee.

Lastly, the contact information we have on file is out of date. A letter was sent to Blayne Dennis on January 5, 2018 (enclosed). To date, the Division has not yet received a response. Please update this information to ensure that all material regarding this permit is sent to the right person and address.

The Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) had been made aware that Martin Bauer no longer represents Jubilee Venture, Inc. Furthermore the address and phone number we have on file is no longer current. Per Rule 1.16 it is your responsibility to notify the Division.

1.16 ADDRESS CHANGE, SALE OF PROPERTY BY AN OPERATOR, OR BUSINESS NAME OR OWNERSHIP CHANGE, AND NOTICE OF FILING OF A PETITION IN BANKRUPTCY

(1) It shall be the duty of the Operator to keep the Office notified of any mailing address change by promptly sending written notice of such change to the Office. The Office is entitled to assume, in the absence of such Notice, that it may proceed with the last previous address provided by the Operator, and the Operator will be bound by such Notice as if actually received.

(2) Where an Operator is the owner of the lands to be mined and the Operator sells such lands, the Operator shall promptly notify the Office of such sale.

(3) Where an Operator's official business name changes or there is a change in business ownership or business form, the Operator shall contact the Office within 30 days of such change in order to revise performance and financial warranty documents and complete the Succession of Operator forms.

(4) Where an Operator files a petition in bankruptcy, the Operator shall immediately notify the Office via certified mail of such filing.

To resolve this problem you will need to do one of the following;

Option 1) if the company name remains Jubilee Ventures, Inc. then please provide the Division with updated contact information. Submit a letter to the address below, include the permit number, contact person, address, phone number and email address.

OR



Option 2) if the company name has changed you will need to transfer the permit to the new company. A 'Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application Packet' is enclosed.

Please submit the corrective action information by **Friday, February 16, 2018.**

As defined by the Minerals Rules, a Technical Revision (TR) is: “a change in the permit or application which does not have more than a minor effect upon the approved or proposed Reclamation or Environmental Protection Plan.” The Division is charged with determining if the revision as submitted meets this definition. If the Division determines that the proposed revision is beyond the scope of a TR, the Division may require the submittal of a permit amendment to make the required or desired changes to the permit.

The request for a TR is not considered “filed for review” until the appropriate fee is received by the Division (as listed below by permit type). Please submit the appropriate fee with your request to expedite the review process. After the TR is submitted with the appropriate fee, the Division will determine if it is approvable within 30 days. If the Division requires additional information to approve a TR, you will be notified of specific deficiencies that will need to be addressed. If at the end of the 30 day review period there are still outstanding deficiencies, the Division must deny the TR unless the permittee requests additional time, in writing, to provide the required information.

There is no pre-defined format for the submittal of a TR; however, it is up to the permittee to provide sufficient information to the Division to approve the TR request, including updated mining and reclamation plan maps that accurately depict the changes proposed in the requested TR.
