
Teller County appreciates the opportunity to comment on Mr. Gary W. Pollack's request for a hard rock permit for Surface Mining and Reclamation on unpatented claim (s) at or near Section 27, Township 11S, Range 71W, 6th Principle Meridian, in Teller County. It is also our understanding that an application decision will be rendered on or about February 8, 2018 on this matter.

Teller County recognizes that State and Federal agencies have programs in place to permit, inspect, and enforce requirements at mining operations to assure protection of the environmental resources associated with such mining operations. It is the intent of Teller County to assure that the local land use planning and zoning requirements are addressed without unnecessary duplication of or in contradiction with, the pertinent State and Federal requirements. *LUR, Section 8.3.S.3.U. Mining*. Therefore, once Mr. Pollack obtains all of the necessary Federal and State permitting he will be required to present those materials to Teller County and apply for the Special Use Permit.

Teller County has no objections to this application as requested but will require a Special Use Permit application approved by the Board of County Commissioners prior to the commencement of any mining activity on the site (s).

We look forward to working with Mr. Pollack on his SUP application.

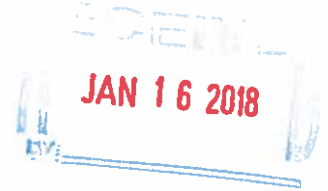

Please be advised that on January 10, 2018, Gary W Pollack, whose address and telephone number are 11415 Palomar St., Spring Hill, FL 34609; (352) 263-5238, filed an application to conduct a Surface mining and reclamation operation, at or near Section 27, Township 11S, Range 71W, 6th Principle Meridian, in Teller County. Please be advised that the permit area may be located in more than one Section, Township, and Range. Affected lands will be reclaimed to support a post-mining land use. The application decision date is scheduled for February 8, 2018.
