Dear Mr. Ebert and all Concerned Authorities,

Even though LaPorte is deemed a hub where a majority of heavy Industry and proliferation of surface mining is situated, it is my understanding that

for the past years, LaPorte remains a non-classifiable area under the NAAQS.

In lieu that Prevention of Significant deterioration (**PSD**) of the Clean Air Act requires a New Source Review (**NSR**) which requires Federal Land

Manager(**FLM**) Notification of **new Source within 100 miles of Federally Protected areas**- Please accept this letter as a formal request for

information on whether a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (**PSD**) Permit is applicable in the consideration of the Loveland ready Mix application.

LaPorte residents are concerned of a possible violation of the Clean Air Act in relation to the proposed LRM site's proximity to several Federally

protected areas that are located close to the community of LaPorte .

### **These Federally Protected Lands close to LaPorte are:**

1. The Greyrock Mountain National Recreation Trail - 13 miles away from LaPorte and proposed 123 acre Loveland Ready Mix mining & processing site
2. Cache La Poudre Wilderness - 28 miles away from laPorte and the proposed NEW SOURCE LRM
3. Mount McConnel National Recreation Trail - 29 miles from LaPorte and the proposed NEW SOURCE LRM
4. Roosevelt National Forest - 38 miles from LaPorte and the proposed NEW SOURCE LRM
5. Rocky Mountain National Park - 64 miles from LaPorte and the proposed NEW SOURCE LRM

Owing to a previous incident that had occurred in LaPorte 1994 when the area had been blanketed by 'acidic dust' particulates, the concerned citizens

of LaPorte are appealing to the authorities to help avert another DONORA INCIDENT resulting from the proliferation of surface mining and heavy

industry in the heart of the community.
