The safety of Customers, Visitors, Contractors, and Employees is extremely important to us. The following guidelines were established to enhance your safety and to provide you with guidelines while on our property. All equipment entering this operation must meet DOT, OSHA and/or MSHA safety requirements. Should you have any questions regarding any of these policies, please see any member of our management staff. Unless you have been provided MSHA Part 46/48 training, you must be escorted by a Martin Marietta Representative at all times.

1. Seat belts must be worn at all times.
2. Observe and obey all posted Informational, Traffic, and Warning signs.
3. Company vehicles and equipment have the Right of Way at all times.
4. Make eye contact with all equipment operators to ensure they see you.
5. Stay in your truck at all times.
6. Do not park, drive or walk behind any other vehicle.
7. Be careful when backing. Use alarm if one is available. If no alarm is available, please use a spotter.
8. If vehicle is unattended; place the controls in park or neutral, set parking brake and chock wheels.
9. Travel in authorized areas **ONLY**.
10. If you must raise your truck bed, do so only in a level area, and well away from other vehicles. Lower the bed completely before moving the vehicle.
11. Dump excess material and tarp your loads in designated areas only. Fall protection equipment is required to be worn if you climb on or into the truck bed.
12. Be aware of overhead power lines or other overhead obstructions.
13. Stop completely before crossing any railroad track. Look and listen for moving rail equipment.
14. Report any accident or injury immediately to the office.
15. No firearms, illegal drugs, or alcohol are permitted on the property. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted on company property.
16. The dumping of hazardous material or washing out truck beds containing residue of hazardous material is strictly prohibited on Martin Marietta property.
17. SDS's are available on request. Under MSHA/OSHA regulations, you must provide to Martin Marietta employees, information on any hazardous chemicals or materials you bring onto this property.
18. Be alert at all times, and stay clear of moving equipment.
19. Do not smoke where there is a possibility of fire or where warning signs prohibit it.

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20. Avoid areas where welding operations are being conducted. If you must enter these areas, wear the proper eye and respiratory protection.

21. Be aware of hazards created by adverse weather conditions. These may include: heavy rain, lightning, hail, high winds, extreme temperatures, snow and ice.

22. Make yourself aware of the plant warning signals (blasting, fire and evacuation). If possible, stay clear of all areas where blasting/loading operations are in progress.

23. Inspect high walls for loose or falling material prior to approaching the face.

24. Do not work near moving equipment unless it is absolutely necessary and had been authorized by Plant Management.

25. Before working on any equipment, make sure it is stopped, locked out and blocked to prevent movement.
