Dear Mr. Czapla:

Tetra Tech, Inc. (Tetra Tech) on behalf of the Gallegos Corporation is submitting this response to the complaint from Mr. Bob Raymond regarding the operator's loss of legal right to enter the affected area to conduct harvesting and reclamation activities. The Permanent Easement, Staging Area and Maintenance Agreement (PESAMA) dated December 30, 2009 granted by Mr. Robert V. Raymond to the Gallegos Masonry, Inc. (GMI) is currently in litigation in District Court Gunnison County, Colorado. While it is difficult to predict the duration of legal proceedings, the trial date is set for mid-May 2018 barring any lengthy appeals based on advice from GMI's attorney.

GMI has retained Mr. William P. Balaz Jr., Tetra Tech, to find an alternate access to the 112 permit area on United States Forest Service (USFS) lands and the staging area on Mr. Raymond's land included in the PESAMA. To date, Tetra Tech has identified two potential access alternatives accessing the USFS lands from Gunnison County Road 3 through private property. GMI is pursuing these access alternatives having previously initiated discussions with one landowner and is in the process of contacting the other property owner. Updates on the litigation and the alternate access discussions will be provided to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety as new information becomes available.
