Dear Mr. Simmons:

Mountain Coal Company, LLC (MCC) submits the attached annual reclamation report for 2017. The 8.96 disturbed acres includes 1.2 acres from pads and roads for four (4) exploration holes completed after approval of Minor Revision Nos. MR-423 (i.e. 17LC-01, 17LC-05 and 17LC-06 with 0.8 acres disturbed and reclaimed) and MR-424 (i.e. 17LC-07 with 0.4 acres disturbed and reclaimed). Also completed were eleven (11) drill pads and road segments that were constructed to complete twelve (12) mine ventilation boreholes (MVBs) (See Table I). The MVBs constructed this year were for longwall panel E7 and included MVBs E7-1 through E7-12.

In 2017, MCC plugged and abandoned eighteen (18) MVBs, one (1) former water monitoring well, and eight (8) older and recent exploration holes (see MR-427). Reclamation was completed on the four (4) exploration sites and roads approved by MR-423 and MR-424 (see above), as well as seven (7) MVB pads (for E5-09 and E5-12/13 through E5-18) and associated access roads (See Table II). The 8.96 acres of reclamation included regrading the sites and roads to the approximate original contour, as well as topsoiling, seeding and mulching. A copy of the seed mix invoice is attached.
