Hi hope the new years has found you well.

I have some questions regarding the "State pit"
Vineland colorado
36th lane. Permit te Fremont Paving redi mix.
I noticed during a review of the permit that no current inspection has been conducted as to date.
I believe you stated you were going to come last spring.

List of concerns:

1. State pit - violation in question.
 - A. Over night stays on state land. (this refers to a person spending the night on the property.) This is a rule by the state of colorado.
 - B. Minning out side boundary area. (Special focus on North/East side.
 - C. Slop of grade in or around Gas Lines
 - D. Dirt and top soil that was used to build the new burns
Located on West and South side of permitted area.
Was the top soil set aside for reclomation used to build these burms. These burms are not addressed in the permit.
 - E. How these new burms affect Strom water diversion. In the original permit, It states the land is flate so there is very little Strom water run off. That is no longer the case.
I personally witnessed a large rain occurrence and the water was being diverting under 36th ln. and on to another parcel of land on the west side of the road.
It seems this could affect the integrity of the road and damages to the parcel west.

Please address these issues of this permit. It has been some time since this permit has been inspected.
