COMMENTS:

Albert Frei and Sons Inc. ("AFS") has submitted a request for full reclamation responsibility release for the permitted area of the Stagecoach Stop Pit, Permit No. M-1983-067. The Stagecoach Stop Pit is primarily located in the SW1/2 of the SW1/4 of Section 26 and the W1/2 of the NW1/4 of Section 35, all in Township 1 South, Range 67 West of the 6th P.M., and contains one lined pond, designated as Stagecoach Stop Reservoir (WDID 0203014). The northern portion of the reservoir's slurry wall encroaches onto the Worthing Pit (DRMS M-1977-526) which is also owned and operated by AFS. The slurry wall was provisional approved on August 7, 2012 while active mining continued to occur within the liner boundary. The final liner for the reservoir was approved by the State Engineer's Office on August 4, 2015.

The State Engineer's Office has no objection to the request for the full reclamation responsibility release for the Stagecoach Pit. Water shall not be impounded in the reservoirs except pursuant to lawful diversions allowed by statute or decree. At all other times, all inflow of water into the reservoirs from any source, including precipitation and ground water inflows, shall be removed by the applicant. The applicant may contact the State Engineer's Office with any questions.
