- ☒ The proposed operation does not anticipate exposing groundwater. Therefore, exposure of ground water must not occur during or after mining operations.
 - ☒ Should water be required for any purpose at the site, the applicant will need to document that the water was obtained from a legal source.
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COMMENTS: The subject application is for a surface mining operation on 25.1 permitted acres located in southeastern Logan County. The primary commodities to be mined at the site are sand and gravel. The site is proposed to be reclaimed to its current use of cropland upon completion of mining.

The site is proposed to be mined to a depth of approximately 25 feet. The mine floor will remain a minimum of two feet above the static water level to prevent exposure of ground water. No water is proposed to be used at the site, and there are no anticipated water diversions or impoundments.
