On April 19, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Fuel storage was cited as a problem for the lack of secondary containment. Corrective actions required that all storage tanks, petroleum and any hazardous materials on site have appropriate secondary containment and submit photo documentation by the corrective action date.

On March 19, 2018 the Division received a letter giving the specifications of an earthen secondary containment that was constructed as well as photo documentation of such. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.
