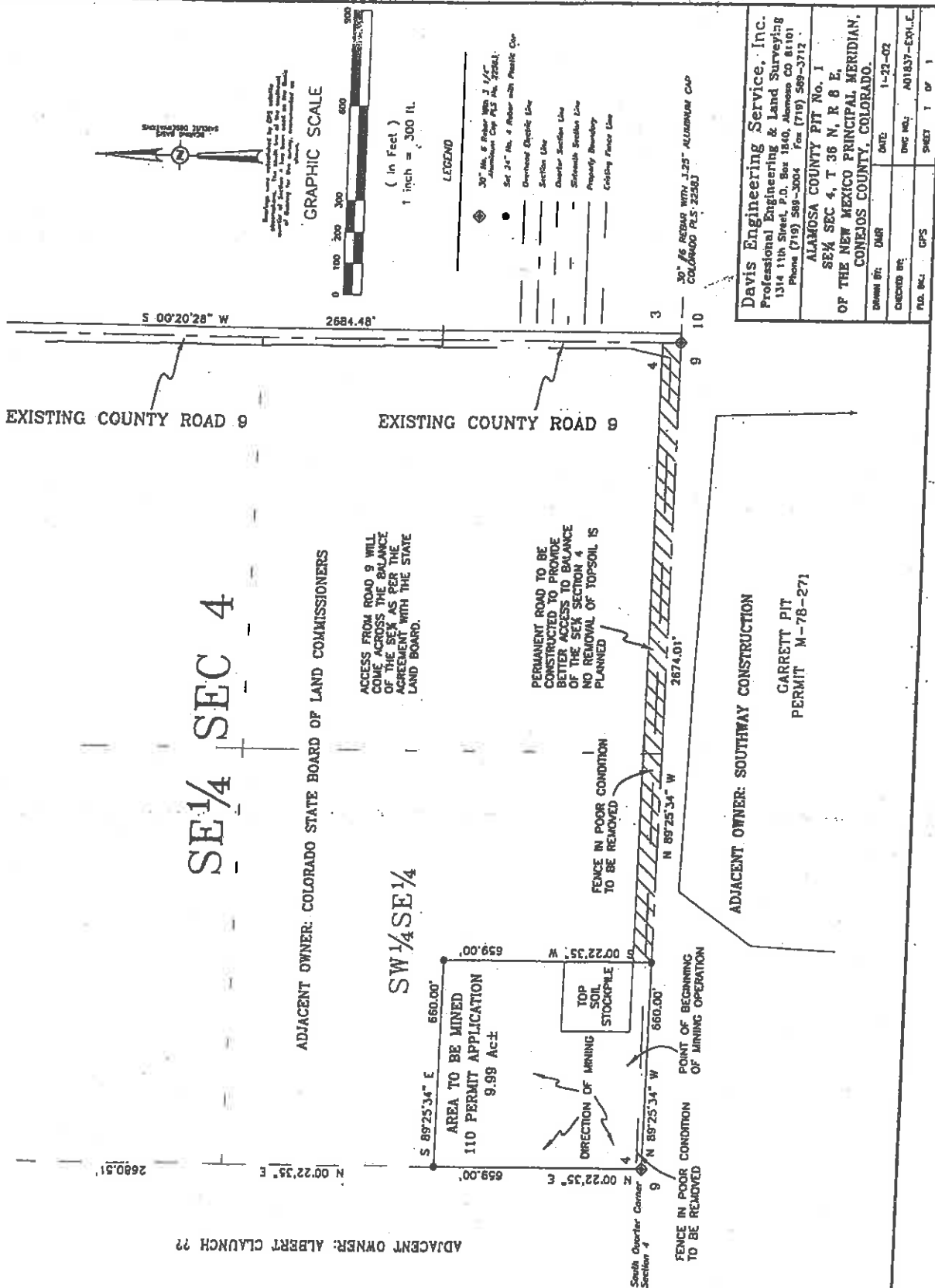
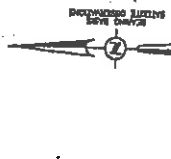

LOCATION INSET

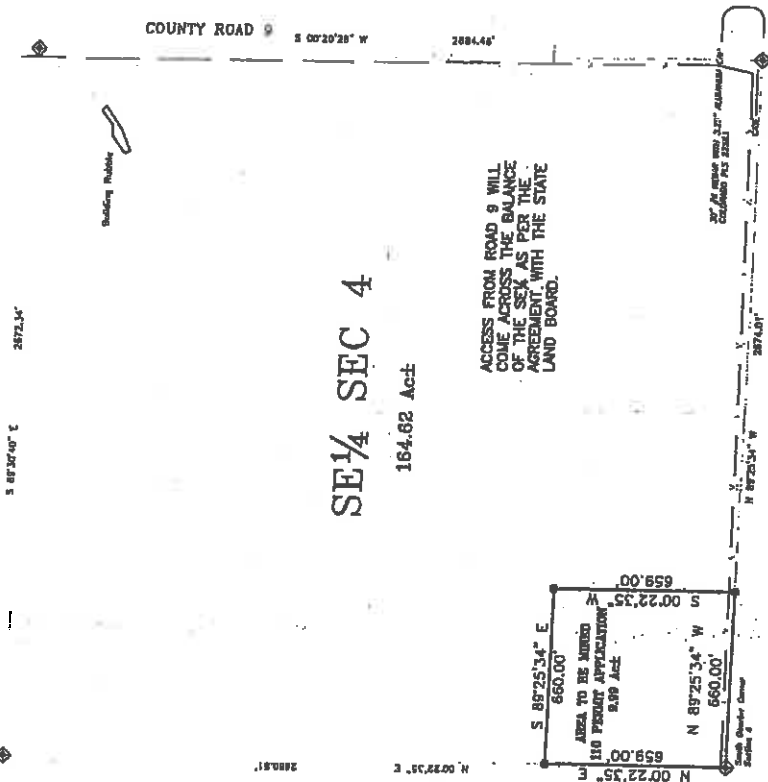

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION TO BE PERMITTED

A tract of land located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, Township 35 North, Range 8 East, New Mexican Principal Meridian, Conejos County, Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

beginning at the South Quarter Corner of said Section 18, as more particularly by a 30.00 inch long No. 8 rebar pin with a 3/4 inch diameter cap set by PLS No. 22483, E along the west line of said S 87-25-34 E a distance of 650.00 feet, thence S 89-25-34 E a distance of 680.00 feet, thence S 89-25-34 E a distance of 539.00 feet to a point on the south line of said S 87-25-34 E, along said south line a distance of 680.00 feet, to the True Point of Beginning, containing 9.99 acres, more or less.

This description was prepared by Daniel M. Russell, US No. 22583, on July 21, 2001. Bearings were determined by GPS Observations and are referenced to the south line of this tract, monumented as shown on the survey plat.
