The Munger Canyon Mine is located approximately 18 miles north of Loma, CO along State Highway 139. East Salt Creek is located on western portion of the permit boundary. Most of the surface of the permit area is owned by the United States. The permit area is encompassed within portions of Sections 22, 27, 28 and 29 of Township 7 South, Range 102 West, 6th P.M. A portion of the permit area in section 29 is owned by #11 Enterprises. The mine site sections are contained within the U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute Howard Canyon and Garvey Canyon Quadrangle maps.
