Dear Mr. Buster,

Per our telephone conversation today, this letter is being provided to clarify the Division's position regarding the difference between a Permittee and an Operator of a mining operation. Pursuant to Rule 1.1(40), a Permittee is any person holding a mining Permit. Whereas pursuant to Rule 1.1(36), an Operator is any person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation engaged in or controlling a mining operation. The Permittee and the Operator of a mine may be the same entity. However, there is no requirement that the Permittee conducts the mining operation. It is not uncommon for a Permittee to contract the mining to a different entity or operator. The Permittee is ultimately responsible for ensuring compliance with the Reclamation Permit and for ensuring all affected lands are reclaimed.
