The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) would like to thank you for your inquiry into the above referenced site. In the inquiry you ask 35 questions and request that DRMS respond to them. Unfortunately DRMS will not be responding to the questions as most are outside the Division's jurisdiction, request subjective answers and/or personal opinions from DRMS staff.

In an informal email exchange on April 5, 2018 I directed you to the DRMS website and the public document review for this site as well as a link to the Act and Rules that govern the once proposed activities at this site.
