OBSERVATIONS

This inspection conducted as part of the routine inspection program established by the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The White River S&G Pit is a 6.7 acre 110c gravel pit located approximately 1.5 miles east of Meeker Colorado.

A mine identification sign was posted at the entrance of the site which is in compliance with the requirements of Rule 3.1.12. Boundary markers in the form of fencing and t-posts were observed around the entire perimeter of the pit.

The operation was active during the inspection but no mining activity was taking place. The activity consisted of construction material removal.

The eastern extent of the permit had been regraded and vegetated in accordance with the approved reclamation plan. The eastern end of the high wall located along the northern permit boundary was partially backfilled.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.
