Dear Mr. Russell:

Attached (via electronic upload) are the completed 2018 Annual Report form, map, annual fee and evidence of weed control for the Barnhart Pit, M-1984-008. With the submittal of the Annual Report form, map and fee, we believe the annual reporting requirements for M-1984-008 have been met. In addition, significant work continues to be done to remove/control Russian olive and saltcedar around the two ponds and on an area just north and east of ponds #1 and #2. These actions are in conformance with the approved weed control plan dated October 15, 2014, included, in part, below.

Following is the schedule for the weed control program. Refer to the included map for weed locations.

| YEAR | SPRING (April – May) | FALL (late August – September) |

| 2015 | Spray all Russian knapweed, the musk thistle, and the Canada thistle. Removal of half of Russian olive/saltcedar near Townsend Dr. | Respray all Russian knapweed, the musk thistle, and the Canada thistle. Removal of the remaining Russian olive/saltcedar near Townsend Dr. |
| 2016 | Removal of half the Russian olive/saltcedar surrounding the small pond and large pond. | Removal of remaining half the Russian olive/saltcedar surrounding the small pond and large pond. Weed survey and mapping in the southeast portion of the site along Arkansas River. |
| 2017 | Spray and cut weeds identified along the Arkansas River. | Spray and cut weeds identified along the Arkansas River. |

The wetlands were seeded last year with species approved by the Corp. of Engineers and by the DRMS. The seeding will be evaluated this year and appropriate action taken to intercede as needed and/or revise the seed mix.


