Dear Mr. Olivares:

On April 30, 2018 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your response via email, regarding the Problem identified during the March 28, 2018 inspection conducted at the Salt Canyon Project and cited in the inspection report dated April 5, 2018. The Division has changed the status of the Corrective Action associated with the following cited Problem to be <u>resolved</u>:

Problem/Possible Violation: The affected area boundary markers are missing on all but the east side of the affected area. This is a problem for failure to maintain boundary markers around the affected area as required by Section 3.1.12(2) of the rule.

The Operator's representative submitted photographs of boundary markers and survey images demonstrating the boundary markers have been placed and the material stockpile in question is within the affected area boundary.
