The following inspection topics were identified as having Problems or Possible Violations. PROBLEM: A vegetative cover is not yet established at the site and reseeding efforts will be necessary. The site has been in final reclamation for greater than five years.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Reseed the site in accordance with the approved reclamation plan. Provide documentation to the Division demonstrating that reseeding efforts have been completed.

CORRECTIVE ACTION DUE DATE: 11/30/18

PROBLEM: Several infestations of knapweed were noted throughout the site.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Treat the knapweed in accordance with the approved weed control plan. Provide documentation to the Division demonstrating the weed control efforts have been performed.

CORRECTIVE ACTION DUE DATE: 7/02/18

OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. The operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate the conditions observed.

The West End Gravel Pit #1 is located approximately five miles east of Naturita and accessed from 90 Road. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 39.4 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$50,075.00 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

On June 28, 2012 the Mined Land Reclamation Board found the operator in violation for failure to complete final reclamation of the site within five years of completion of mining, and ordered the operator to begin reclamation of the site. At this time all reclamation earthwork has been adequately completed. However, an adequate vegetative cover is not yet established. C.R.S. 34-32.5-116 (4)(f) requires that a diverse, effective and long-lasting vegetative cover be established that is capable of self-regeneration and is at least equal, with respect to extent of cover, to the natural vegetation of the surrounding area. Volunteer vegetation, such as sagebrush and rabbit brush, is becoming established in parts of the permit area, but the majority of the affected area remains barren of desirable vegetation. Reseeding the site will be necessary in order to reestablish vegetative cover at the site. Additionally, because of the lack of desirable vegetative cover, the site is susceptible to noxious weed infestations. Knapweed was noted throughout the site and should be treated immediately.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
