

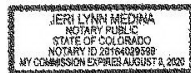

PUBLIC NOTICE

Minrec, Inc., 627 24 1/2 Road, Unit H, Grand Junction, CO 81505 has submitted a complete application for a technical revision to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety for its North Thompson Creek Mines, mining permit no. C-1991-022. This technical revision number 22 will suspend the water monitoring on upstream and downstream North Thompson Creek.

The permit area consists of the lands located in Sections 27, 34, and 35, T 8 S, R 89 W, 6th P.M. and Sections 2 and 3 T 9 S, R 89 W, 6th P.M. more fully described below. The surface of the mine permit area is owned by the North Thompson-Four Mile Mineral and Land Corporation (portions of sections 27, 34 and 35 T 8 S.), the Crystal River Ranch Company (portions of sections 2 and 3 T 9 S, and sections 34 and 35 T 8 S), and the U. S. Forest Service (portion of section 27 T 8 S).

The mine permit area is located approximately 9.5 miles from the bridge across the Crystal River on County Road 108, (North Thompson Creek Road). The permit area can be located on the U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute Stony Ridge, CO quadrangle map. The total permit area encompasses 1,093.5 acres of which 20 acres are on USDA-FS managed surface.
