I reviewed the changes in the proposal and the map, as we discussed in person the other day. While the project is changed from the original proposal, it is within the scope and scale of the initial analysis and the changes are minor. There will be no additional significant impacts to threatened, endangered, proposed, or candidate species, Forest Sensitive species, or management indicator species.
