


RECLAMATION MAP

DISTANCE VALUES




SUBJECT PARCEL & DESCRIPTION

Contains 6.118 acres more or less.

Beginning at a point in the SE 1/4 of Section 16, Twp, Rng, Sec 7, M., which point bears N $16^{\circ} 55' 30''$ E 142' 11 1/2" from the South 1/4 corner of said point bearing a 1336 human cap in a pile of stones), Thence N $16^{\circ} 55' 30''$ E 117' 62" to Thence S $16^{\circ} 55' 30''$ E 42' 8 1/2" to the point of beginning. Thence N $16^{\circ} 55' 30''$ E 117' 62" to Thence S $16^{\circ} 55' 30''$ E 42' 8 1/2" to the point of beginning. No overburden will be stripped due the material is silty deposited into an existing pond and is only a clean out of a pond.

6" of Top soil on average to be spread out over the area of the stockpile area and topsoil area. Ground to be ripped or scarified to prep before seeding. No seed will be needed within the pond area. Any other ground within the permit boundary that was compacted or vegetation destroyed will be scarified and seeded in the same manner as the stockpile area, other than the inside of the pond. No shrubs or trees will be planted.
