Dear Mr. Icabone,

On March 2, 2018, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division or Office) received a Notice of Intent to Conduct Prospecting (NOI) Application for the Wilson Placer site. In correspondence dated April 16, 2018, the Division notified you of deficiencies in the NOI Application. The identified deficiencies were to be addressed within 60 days (June 15, 2018) of the Office notification.

To date, the Division has not received a response to the notice of deficiencies. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 5.1.3(c), the Division has terminated the file for the Wilson Placer NOI. Any appeal of an Office determination shall follow the procedures set forth in Rule 1.4.11. In accordance, with Rule 1.4.11, if you wish to appeal this decision you must petition a hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board within sixty (60) days of the date of the Office decision. Such a petition for a hearing must state how you are directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the Office's decision, and how your interests are entitled to protection under the Act. The petition must list and explain any issues you believe should be considered by the Board at the Hearing on the matter. The petition for a hearing must specifically state the application or file number assigned by the Office (P-2018-004).
