Dear Mr. Bowles,

An inspection of the pond at the King II mine was performed on June 18, 2018 for the 2nd quarter of 2018. 1.86" of rain fell over the previous weekend. The pond contained approximately 8 – 10" of water (see photos) and was not discharging. No leaks were observed around the two 24" spillway culverts. The pond embankment, in-slopes and spillway all appeared stable with no evidence of slumping, settling or excessive erosion. All features appeared to be in place and functioning as designed.
