## RE: Speer Mining Resource, DRMS Permit No. M-1983-176 Notice of Non-Compliance with Adams County Received By DRMS

Dear Mr. Geras,

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division), received documentation from the Adams County Attorney's Office on May 25, 2018 informing the Division that Asphalt Specialties is conducting recycling and filling activities at the above referenced site without a valid conditional use permit and expired filing for the CD (Certificate of Designation).

Please provide the Division a timeline by July 20, 2018 for obtaining compliance with Adams County. In accordance with C.R.S. 34-32.5-109(3), an "operator shall be responsible for assuring that the mining operation and the post mining land use comply with city, town, county or city and county land use regulations and any master plan for extraction adopted pursuant to section 34-1-304 unless a prior declaration of intent to change or waive the prohibition is obtained by the applicant from the affected political subdivisions. Any mining operator subject to this article shall also be subject to zoning and land use authority and regulation by political subdivision as provided by law."

The Division may take enforcement action if the operation occurring at the site continues out of compliance with the requirements of Adams County. If you have any questions feel free to contact me at (303) 866-3567, extension 8120.
