Re: Receipt of 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application, Garrett Pit, Permit No. M-1978-271, AM - 1

Mr. Salazar:

On June 22, 2018, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received all outstanding parts of your 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment application for the Garrett Pit, which is located in Conejos County. Your application is now considered complete and filed. All comment and review periods began on June 22, 2018. The decision date for your application is scheduled for September 20, 2018.

Within ten (10) days after submittal, you must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operation once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks. The public comment period will continue for twenty (20) days after the last date of publication. Immediately after the first publication, mail a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land. Proof of notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested, must be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date. Additionally, any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Conejos County Clerk and Recorder.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed. Please be reminded that all operators must contact the Colorado Department of Health, Water Quality Control Division regarding storm water permits.
