My apologies for the last minute email on this TR. I was going to call Mark, but I cannot find his phone number in my records.

The only question I have with TR request relates to the existing haul road. The Division has no concerns over leaving it for future access, but we need confirmation that is acceptable to the land owner. If Schmidt Construction owns the land, please confirm as much. If not, we need a signed letter from the landowner stating they wish the road to remain after reclamation..

I had been trying to complete my bond estimate and approve the TR today, but the road issue and some challenges with estimating the bond for certain unusual tasks (e.g., removal of the pinyons, offsite disposal of the RAP) have challenged me. The Division's decision date is Monday (7/2). If we can get the landownership/haul road question resolved by then, I'll likely approve on Monday and have to follow up later with a surety increase (as opposed to the TR approval letter requiring the additional bond - I'd also like to give you guys a chance to comment on the bond estimate, given the challenges I've had with it).

Otherwise, we'll need to get a request from you to extend the decision date. If you can get back to me Monday morning on the landowner question, we can work from there.
