Dear Mr. Laroche:

On July 12, 2018 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your request via email from Mr. Bruce Humphries to extend the corrective action due date to August 20, 2018 for Problem No. 2 cited in the January 30, 2018 inspection report. The Division hereby approves the extension request as follows:

**INSPECTION TOPIC:** Reclamation Success

**PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION:** Problem No. 2: The water storage pond added for the rock wash plant as part of amendment 2 (AM-02) is in poor condition due to lack of maintenance, with the liner torn and ineffective.

**CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:** Reclaim the water storage pond as approved by the Division in Amendment 4. Provide photographic evidence of removing the liner prior to any backfill placement, followed by photographs of achieving final grades, and seed tags for the revegetation effort or if appropriate, a schedule for later seeding in 2018 by the corrective action due date.
