## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety normal monitoring program. The Smith Pit No. 20 is a 112c permitted site. It is located approximately 40 miles northeast of Craig and boarders the Wyoming state line. It is accessed from Moffat County Road 4. Amy Yeldell of the Division conducted the inspection.

The mine identification sign and affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with Rule 3.1.12. The site was inactive but well maintained. No structures, trash, equipment or fuel is on site. A large stockpile of process material remains on site. The stockpile is stable with no erosion and slopes are no steeper than a 3:1. Topsoil and overburden piles remain stable and well vegetated. No weeds were noted on site.

This is a government agency therefore the Division does not hold a reclamation bond.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
