## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. The North Amethyst Project is a 6.32 acre prospecting drilling project. Rio Grande Silver, Inc. mine manager Randy McClure was present during the inspection.

The drilling locations are nearly completely reclaimed with only two drill pads remaining to be reclaimed during the inspection. The reclamation work completed on the roads and pads was executed very well. Timber slash was placed over the rough graded and top-soiled roads and pads. Vegetation will likely be quickly established due to the quality of the preparation of the seed bed.

The portions of the roads and pads that were revegetated in 2017 appear to be doing really well even with the lack of precipitation. The revegetated areas that were observed during the July 2017 inspections are considered completely reclaimed. Within the next 1-2 growing seasons all pads and roads will be ready for complete release.

No erosion or sedimentation issues were noted. There are no major or minor drainage issues within the permit area that warrant addressing.
