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### COMMENTS:

Aggregate Industries - WCR, Inc. has submitted a request for partial acreage release for 233 acres permitted area of the Brighton Mine, Permit No. M-1977-436. The 233 acres subject to release contain two lined storage reservoirs, South Reservoir (WDID 0203031) and Central Reservoir (WDID 0203385).

The State Engineer's Office has no objection to the request for partial acreage release for the Brighton Mine. Water shall not be impounded in the reservoirs except pursuant to lawful diversions allowed by statute or decree. At all other times, all inflow of water into the reservoirs from any source, including precipitation and ground water inflows, shall be removed by the applicant.
