The Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) received your update on progress made towards the above mentioned adequacy review on August 30, 2018. The Division acknowledges that rip-rap features are being installed but progress has been delayed due to weather. Additionally a weed management plan is being developed and will be delivered to the Division upon receipt from the contractor.

Remaining adequacy items are; as-built diagrams of rip-rap structures, total straw waddle linear feet installed, stormwater feature map, a noxious weed management plan and proof of weed treatment.

The Division has received your extension request to address the remaining items of TR-4 Adequacy Review 1 items mentioned above. The Division accepts the extension request. The new decision due date for TR-4 has been set for September 9, 2018.
