Summary and Resolution of Interaction:

On August 21, 2018, Mrs. Dorothy Kinease left a voicemail for Erica Crosby with the AML program stating the prospector was removing equipment from the underground mine and storing it on her property.

On August 27, 2018, Mrs. Kinease stated during a phone conversation heavy equipment and a cylinder were stored on the property owned by the Prospector immediately adjacent the in front of her residence.

On August 27, 2018, Mr. John Miner with COAG Corporation stated during a phone conversation the items stored on the property adjacent to Mrs. Kinease's residence were antique mining equipment and a 7,000 gallon water tank. The water tank will be used for fire mitigation water while cabins are constructed in the area on properties owned by the Prospector. Mr. Miner stated the tank would be relocated in the near future. Mr. Miner stated he would send pictures of the tank to the Division the next time he was at the property.



On August 27, 2018, the Division informed Mrs. Kinease the storage of equipment on the property adjacent to her residence was not considered mining related activity and no further action would be taken by the Division. Mrs. Kinease was encouraged to contact the Division in the future if new evidence of mining activity outside of the permit NOI boundary was available.
