Subject: Request for additional time, Amzak Pit, M2003-003 Succession of Operators

Dear Mr. West:

As we have discussed, and I understand the situation, there are two items necessary to complete the Succession of Operator of the Amzek Pit from Consolidated Constructors to Richardson Construction Kemble Excavation JV (RCKE):

- 1. Updated third-party financial warranty documents, required from Consolidated Constructors.
- 2. Updated documentation regarding significant manmade structures.

We have again hit the deadline for completing these actions, and while progress has been made, we need an additional extension. This letter requests an extension to that deadline, for reasons explained below. WASTELINE Inc. and RCKE have been working to obtain this documentation, but continue to be delayed and thwarted by unanticipated and unusual circumstances.

Consolidated Constructors is getting their paperwork in order, and we are in frequent contact with them to get that submitted to Barb.

The primary delay continues to be the ownership of the fenced pad on the western edge of the permitted area, on CR-136. We have been able to identify the type and status (abandoned) and have sent letters requesting structure agreements from the three entities which all claim to be (or have been) owners, but have received an offer of an alternative agreement from just one of the three. That alternative agreement has to be agreed to by the landowner and not the successor operator.

Although it is unlikely to take so long, I am requesting an additional 60-day extension to obtain this documentation. In addition to the third-party financial warranty documents, we may need to request a waiver to the usual process for requesting an indemnity agreement, and to proceed directly to an engineering evaluation.
