On September 10, 2018 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) approved the Technical Revision request (TR-4) submitted on July 12, 2018, addressing the following:

- 3. As-built map depicting rip-rap channels and straw waddle placement

To date all BMP's required under TR-3 have been installed. Only minor touch up seeding to disturbed areas remains.
